Version 4 of the CBECC-Res 2013 compliance software is now available for <u>download from</u> <u>the project website</u>. New features include:

- Improved compliance processing speed almost twice as fast as Version 3c for typical projects
- Dedicated boilers for hydronic space heating
- Refrigerant charge test for ductless (mini-split) heat pumps
- Notes for documention and notes to be printed on the CF1R
- Insulated roof tile systems by Green Hybrid Roofing
- Ducts located in specific attics

Version 4 also corrects several software bugs and reporting errors primarily relating to:

- Addition and Alteration modeling and HERS reporting issues
- HERS reporting errors for mini-splits and for ductwork under certain conditions
- Water heating assumptions for a ground source heat pumps

Version 4 was approved by the Energy Commission this week. All permit applications made on or after August 1, 2015 must use CBECC-Res 2013 Version 4.
